For several years he played Men's Doubles with his father Claude in the Ontario Playdowns winning in 1989 and 1993

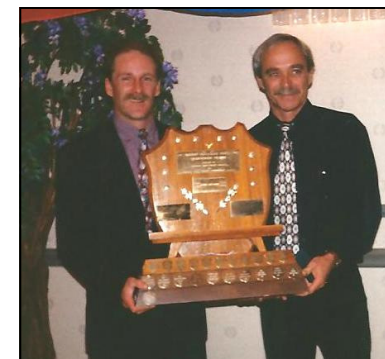
At nineteen years of age the Crites family was pretty much all playing shuffleboard so they decided to form a family team made up of John, his parents and his aunts and uncles.
